About the Instructor:

- Strong: Really enthusiastic, great teacher, and knowledgeable. Presents material clear and straight-forward. Improve: Sometimes makes silly mistakes that confuse the class for a little bit. However, always makes the point clear.
- Strong: Solid, helpful, knowledgeable, and humorous. Improve: Return assignments.
- Clear materials, problem sets, and exams are relevant to materials taught.
- Great instructor, helpful and clear. Improve: Some small typos on the board, but nothing worth complaining about at all.
- Good knowledge of the material. Improve: More homework might have been useful. Summer term though so time was an issue.
- Enthusiastic, presents the material well, and cares about the students. Improve: Do more real life examples as opposed to only theory.
- Very clear in explaining the material and answers any questions one may have. Homework assignments are very relevant.
- Very clear presentation of the material, going to class was really helpful. Encourages questions and open discussion. Improve: Maybe a little more numerical examples would be helpful, but overall he is a really good teacher.
- He is enthusiastic and answers questions well. He knows the material and is generally well prepared. Improve: He sometimes improvises on the spot (with numerical examples) that don't work out.
- Good diction, easy to understand. He clearly wants to interact with us and the material; i.e. help us work through any misunderstandings. Improve: Spend less time looking for us to know why. The class isn't talkative unfortunately.
- Excellent lecture style. The right ratio of lecturing on the board and interacting with the students, and the right ratio of explaining the economic concepts and relating them to the real world. Excellent pacing. Great professor.
