



# **About the Program**

This five-month, online certificate program equips learners with the knowledge and skills to effectively lead interprofessional teams. Our program is designed for individuals with three or more years of professional experience in any health profession or setting, who lead, or aspire to lead, interprofessional teams. Learners participate in weekly live online classrooms and engage with self-paced online learning modules featuring interactive exercises, videos, and journals.

### **Course Details**

- Cost: \$1,000 for the entire program
- 5 courses (4 weeks per course)
- 2 hours weekly (1 hour online live classroom and 1 hour self-paced online learning module)
- 100 percent online
- Open to all health professionals with 3 or more years of experience
