1. The Interprofessional Team

Recognize the value of interprofessional collaborative practice, develop team-based approaches to managing ethical issues, and apply practical strategies to foster collaborative teamwork.

2. Effective Communication

Enhance interprofessional communication through reflection on communication theory, techniques, and self-awareness; and develop confidence motivating teams and managing conflict.

3. Effective Supervision

Integrate learning theories and practical strategies to enhance student learning on clinical placement; and develop skills necessary for effective professional supervision and mentorship.

4. Building Business Acumen

Understand financial management principles; and develop effective strategies to market and evaluate organizational capacity to offer services.

5. Leadership of Interprofessional Teams

Explore the challenges and opportunities of leading interprofessional teams, reflect on leadership styles, and apply contemporary leadership models to effect meaningful change






